



FOR REFERENCE ONLY

For the last 25 years I have made at least one trip to Canada per year, sometimes two. I always have certain animals that I want to see in person but also try to visit 3 or 4 farms that I have never been to. Usually I can visit 8-12 farms per trip. And you never know what you might find! 9 or 10 years ago I remember going to Troy Cerny and admiring his Amigo daughters and what nice udders that they had. So that led me to go to Andy Oslanski to see his mother - Massey 229P who in my opinion was and still is the best South African cow that I had seen.

So low and behold about 5 to 6 years after that I go to Spruceburn Ranch and Donna has this fantastic son of 229P called Classic. At that time Classic was 2 ½ years old and Donna showed me his first calves and I am thinking wow. Of course I tried to purchase the bull and tried every angle that I could think of but Donna was having absolutely none of it! But true to her word I got an email saying she had so many daughters and would sell the bull. All along Donna kept telling me he was the best bull she had ever used and I said Donna, how can you say that when you had SAF 73H? (If you can find his semen expect to pay \$1,000+) Donna's reply was, "it is really easy, Stanley - SAF 73H sired some great females but not good bulls." Classic sires both! And after watching Classic's second calf-crop develop, Donna you are spot on!

When I could not buy Classic, at first I then proceeded to buy Classic's best son, Luckenbach whom we had great success with. We have kept his best son Joseph (who's mother is a Treasure daughter) and is our main heifer bull and the service sire to several of the bred heifer calves. Be sure to check him out!

Unfortunately, Classic's semen will not freeze so the only two places to secure his genetics are Red Deer County, Alberta and Postville, Iowa.





The early years...

Born in 1947 the youngest of seven children. We milked 40 cows and bottled our own milk and delivered it, door-to-door in town, before school each morning. We also had 30 sows and 200 laying hens.

My mother taught Sunday School in German and milked cows by hand in the morning and delivered my 10 pound brother that same afternoon. Mother would make butter and cottage cheese every Saturday morning.

My father owned one of the first small square balers in our county—so custom baling was a way of life. When I was 13 years old, I was old enough to drive the tractor to bale hay. Each and everyday (that is was fit) we baled hay all summer long and into the fall. Dad would come and get me out of school to bale hay. I got so tired of baling that I never wanted to see another cow!

For my freshman FFA project I purchased two registered Hampshire bred gilts. One for \$67.50 and the other for \$75.00. Little did I know where that would take me! When I graduated from high school in 1965, the choices were Viet-Nam or college. Neither of which appealed to me! My first year at Iowa State University one of my pigs set the world record for loin-eye, size 9.13 sq. in.

But my life was completely impacted in a positive way, when I met the swine herdsman at Iowa State. Al Christian took me under his wing and was like a second father. Al judged an immense number of swine shows and lead by example as to how to handle people. Thanks Al!!!

As a sophomore, I won the collegiate livestock judging contest, which consisted of beef cattle, hogs, sheep, and horses. Four classes of each, with four in a class. We also had to give oral reasons for two classes of each species. So you had to remember what you had seen! I had never judged horses or sheep before I got to ISU. It was a proud moment for me!

Dec. 1, 1969 — I was drafted into the United States Marine Corp., and on Dec. 29, 1969 my father died unexpectedly of a brain aneurysm.

July of 1971 — I showed my first National Champion boar - Linebacker was named Reserve Grand Champion Hampshire boar at the National Type Conference held in Madison, Wisc.

In July of 1972, another breeder and I paid \$11,000 for a boar we named Lumberjack. A world record at the time. Some of the folks in Postville thought I had lost my mind! In August 1972 I went out one morning and one of Lumberjack's testicles was swollen up the size of a basketball! I had only gotten two gilts bred to him prior to. That testicle had to be removed and fortunately he was only lost for one breeding season. From Lumberjack's first litter we put two boars in the test station. One sold for \$5,500 and another for \$3,500.

In 1973 we bought the \$7,000 National Champion Iron Horse. From his first litter (when mated to a Lumberjack daughter) came Powerful — who was a National Champion and sold for \$11,000 to Japan.

In 1974 — I was named Master Seed Stock Producer.

In 1981 we purchased a boar we named Kaw-liga that impacted the Hampshire breed like non-other. Each year the Hampshire Assoc. ranked the top boars. In 1985 Kaw-liga was the number one ranked boar with point total of 319, the next closest boar was 86! When we would take our cull barrows and gilts to the buying station, I was told (by several buyers) that these were the best pigs that he bought! Judged national shows here and abroad.

In the early 1990's our herd was twice decimated with psuedorabies. As hard as it was we had to give it up.

We had a handful of Simmental cows in the 70's, even had a direct French and Swiss import (through Canada). Went to the Bar 5 sales. Still good friends with the ageless Wilf Davis—a wonderful man. But if you wanted "unsugar coated" information, you talked to Neil Moffatt, who on many occasions, helped me bring Fleckvieh from all over Canada. We love you Neil! Those two were Bar 5! Alvin, our herdsman, is to our operation much like what Neil was to the Bar 5 operation, the guy that does all the work!

There is absolutely no doubt in my mind that the Fleckvieh herd we have today is bigger and stronger than our Hampshires of the 70's and 80's.

I was not born in the spotlight, but I have paid my dues. I would like to take this moment to thank everyone and anyone that I have met along this great journey.
